

True Italian Taste is realised as part of the government programme 'The Extraordinary Italian Taste', which aims to enhance and promote authentic Italian food products.

The Belgo-Italian Chamber of Commerce developed the project in collaboration with 41 CCIE in 27 countries around the world and aims to raise awareness among foreign consumers on the consumption and conscious purchase of 100% Made in Italy food in order to combat the phenomenon of "Italian Sounding". True Italian Taste is intended to spread a greater knowledge of the characteristics of typicality, places of origin, and nutritional and PDO-PGI certification aspects..



Stay Export is a project of Unioncamere and the Italian Chambers of Commerce, implemented in cooperation with Assocamerestero and the CCIE, aimed at assisting small and medium-sized Italian companies interested in operating in foreign markets.






